


Fingerprint Cam Lock - Operating Instructions



Features:

- Biometric sensor with high sensitivity
- Up to 10 Fingerprint capacity
- Elegant zinc alloy panel design

Locking / Unlocking


- The factory default programming allows any fingerprint to open the lock
- Once a fingerprint has been registered, only programmed fingerprints can open the lock
- A green light will indicate the fingerprint has been accepted and will unlock
- A red light will flash once to indicate the fingerprint was unsuccessful or not registered, and will remain locked

Registering fingerprints

Administrator Fingerprints:

The first 2 fingerprints registered will be the Administrator fingerprints.

- 1. Place the finger to be registered on the sensor for approximately 20-30 seconds. When the green light flashes for the second time release your finger.
- 2. A blue light will illuminate indicating the lock is ready for registration.
- 3. Place the finger to be registered on the sensor, the blue light will flash green
- 4. Release your finger the blue light will illuminate again
- 5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 in quick succession until the green light illuminates for 2 seconds fingerprint registration is successful




- A blue light will illuminate after the first successful registration to accept a second administrator fingerprint for registration.
- After 2 successful administrator fingerprints have been registered, the blue light will indicate that User fingerprints are ready for registration. This process will exit automatically if not operated after 5 seconds.



User Fingerprints:

- Place the Administrator fingerprint on the sensor for approximately 20-30 seconds, waiting for the green light to illuminate for the second time, then release your finger
- 2. A blue light will illuminate indicating the lock is ready for registration.
- 3. Place the finger to be registered on the sensor, the blue light will illuminate green
- 4. Release your finger the blue light will illuminate again
- 5. Repeat steps 3 & 4 in quick succession until the green light illuminates for 2 seconds fingerprint registration is successful



- A blue light will illuminate after the first successful registration to accept a second user fingerprint for registration.
- This process will exit automatically if not operated after 5 seconds.

Removing fingerprints

Method 1:

- 1. Place an **administrator registered fingerprint** on the sensor until a red light illuminates (Approximately 40-60 seconds)
- 2. Once the fingerprint is removed from the sensor all fingerprints will be removed returning it to factory default (any fingerprint can open the lock)

Method 2:

- 1. Insert the "E-Key" into the USB charging slot
- 2. Place any fingerprint on the sensor until a red light illuminates
- 3. Once the fingerprint is removed from the sensor all fingerprints will be removed returning it to factory default (any fingerprint can open the lock)
- 4. Remove the "E-Key" from the charging slot

Charging the lock

If a red light flashes while unlocking, the battery is low and will need to be charged using a USB-C cable or power bank. A blue light will flash during charging, and will illuminate green once fully charged

E-Key

If the E-Key is inserted, any fingerprint placed on the sensor will allow it to be unlocked, functioning as an override method - You can only use the E-Key once in this manner (Remove and re-insert to repeat this function)
